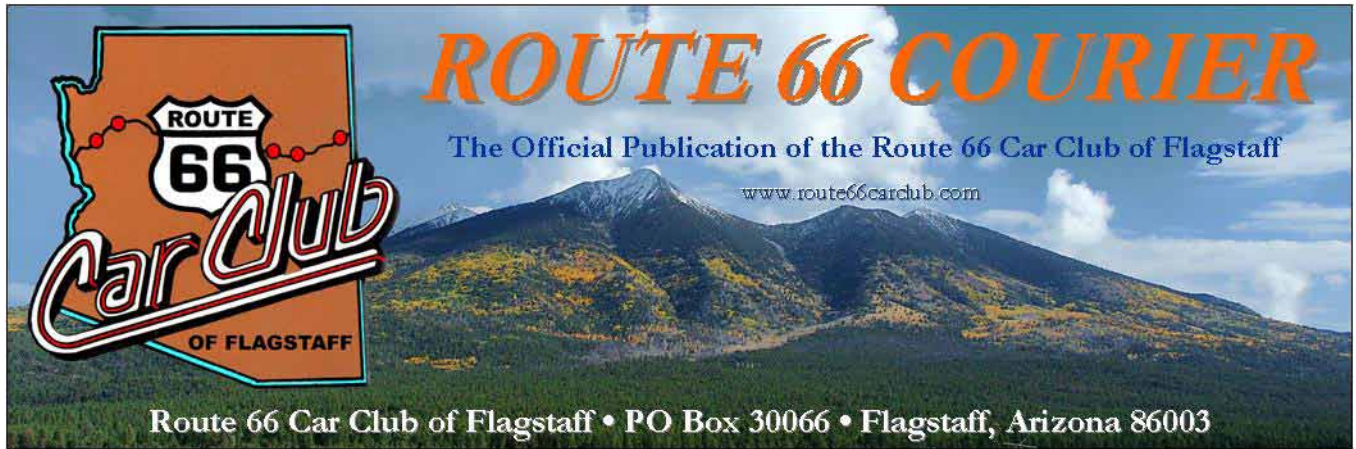

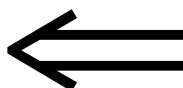

I attended the Gunslinger car show in Holbrook on July 7. Like last year, the setting was great and so was the weather. The show is held in the city park and all cars are on thick grass.

Nothing like being greeted by your name when you check in - they remembered me from last year !! Unfortunately due to competition from car shows in Heber and Payson, there were just 45 cars and 5 motorcycles in the show. Some of their members (24) also brought their own cars but they were in a separate area and were voted on by show participants. Rating of the cars in the show was done by club members (Gearheads) following a fairly complete checklist.



Entertainment during the show was provided by a Mexican dance group (see picture 2) followed by a western card game / shoot-out (see picture). There was also a raffle and a 50:50 drawing. The 50:50 was not won by our Rt66 club since Sean was not there.

The weather was great, lunch was included in the entrance fee and everyone was very friendly and helpful. Unfortunately I was the only one there representing our club but I made up for it by winning two first place trophies for (1) Foreign Car and (2) popular choice.

Dear Club Members,


Like a new parent, at our Clinic, it seems those special milestones come all too quickly. The end of last month was our first six months. And like we did six months ago there are exciting numbers to report. But more importantly we feel we have seen signs that the Flagstaff medical community is accepting us as partners in serving our community. Like a child, we know they will walk still that first step is a momentous occasion.

It all started when Dr. Jack Quigley's and his office, Plastic Surgeons of Northern Arizona, helped us save a man's thumb. We could not have done it without his help and we are forever grateful. Then last month we had two occasions to send patients to Flagstaff Medical Center for services and procedures well beyond our capabilities. They were extremely responsive, treated both our patients without regard to their ability to pay and we believed saved a couple of lives. We are now doing the follow-up work with both patients and hope we are saving the hospital money and time. We thank Dr. Quigley, his staff and Flagstaff Medical Center for being the kind of partners we only imagined a few months ago.

Now on to the numbers every proud parent seems to make a part of any conversation. We provided over 850 patient visits with an estimated value of almost one quarter of a million dollars. If only 20% of these patients had ended up in the emergency room and an average emergency room visit costs the hospital \$856.00, we saved the hospital nearly \$150,000. When you consider we did all this for less than \$22,000 it is pretty remarkable. That means for every dollar we spend we provide ten dollars worth of services. I would venture to guess there is not another non-profit in Flagstaff that can even come close to those numbers.

Once again thank you for your support in the past and I hope this thumbnail summary of the last six months gives you an idea how important your partnership is with us.
